WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution 15-339 the Board of County Commissioners (BOCC) approved a funding agreement with the State Department of Commerce (Commerce) to construct a water system reservoir for the county water utility, Vader-Enchanted Valley Water System; and

WHEREAS, professional engineering design and construction support services are needed; and

WHEREAS, publication to solicit for professional services is needed to complete our contract scope with Commerce.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Department of Public Works is instructed to prepare a RFQ, evaluate responses and negotiate a contract with the qualified consultant for BOCC approval; and the Clerk of the Lewis County BOCC is instructed to proceed with all appropriate and necessary notifications, posting and publication as required by RCW 65.16.

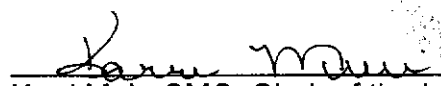

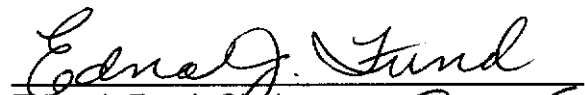

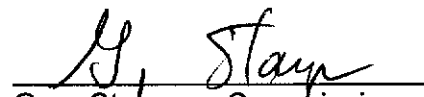

Lewis County is inviting statements of qualification and performance information from qualified firms to provide engineering design (including surveying) and construction support services for a new water reservoir of the Vader-Enchanted Valley Water System located at 1333 S Military Road, Winlock, WA.

One or more firms will be selected for an interview based upon the following criteria categories and weights:

Firms desiring consideration shall submit a complete qualification package to Lewis County Public Works, 2025 NE Kresky Ave, Chehalis, WA 98532 by 11:00 AM on January 19, 2016. The most highly rated firm will be selected for an interview and contract negotiations.
