EXHIBIT A

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INTERGOVERNMENTAL COOPERATIVE PURCHASING AGREEMENT

Pursuant to Chapter 39.34.080 RCW and to other provisions of the law, the COUNTY OF YAKIMA, hereinafter called YAKIMA COUNTY and the following municipal corporation, political subdivision, or other public agency of the State of Washington, LEWIS COUNTY, hereinafter called "The Political Subdivision", hereby agree to cooperative governmental purchasing upon the following terms and conditions.

(1) YAKIMA COUNTY in contracting for the purchase of goods and services for the COUNTY agrees to extend the privileges of said negotiations to other political subdivisions to the extent permitted by law, and agreed upon by the parties hereto, and the vendor(s).

(2) The political subdivision (LEWIS COUNTY) accepts responsibility for compliance with any additional or varying laws and regulations governing purchases by or on behalf of the political subdivision.

(3) YAKIMA COUNTY accepts no responsibility for the performance of any purchasing contract by the vendor, and YAKIMA COUNTY accepts no responsibility for payment of the purchase price by the political subdivision.

(4) The political subdivision (LEWIS COUNTY) assumes the responsibility of contracting independently for the purchase of any goods or services, with or without notice to YAKIMA COUNTY.

(5) YAKIMA COUNTY reserves the right to exclude the undersigned political subdivision, or any class containing the undersigned political subdivision, or political subdivisions in general, from any particular purchasing contract, with or without, notice to the political subdivision.

(6) This agreement shall continue in force until canceled by either party, which cancellation may be affected with or without notice to the other party.

(7) The agreement is for YAKIMA COUNTY contracts that are agreed upon by both parties.
