In conjunction with Breast Cancer Awareness Month in October, the Lewis County Wellness Committee in coordination with the Lewis County Sheriff's Office Association is hosting a Poker Run/Walk in honor of all those affected by cancer. All donations will be donated to Susan G. Komen for the Cure for Breast Cancer.

In addition to supporting Breast Cancer Awareness, the Lewis County Wellness Committee is hoping this Poker Run/Walk will promote individual wellness and encourage employee engagement.

Participants will have an opportunity to be entered into a drawing for a chance to win one of three Amazon gift cards valued at \$50 each, donated by the Lewis County Sheriff's Office Association, along with additional prizes for the best and worst poker hand! Walk the 1-mile designated course and stop at each checkpoint to receive up to five poker cards. Walk the 2-mile designated course and stop at each checkpoint to receive up to seven poker cards. You will use the best of five cards to make your poker hand. A map of the designated 1-mile and 2-mile courses with checkpoints will be provided via e-mail prior to the event. (The walks are on your own with no designated traffic control assistance.)

We hope you will join us for this fun filled event to raise awareness for breast cancer and early detection. This walk is open to the public as well so invite your friends and family to join us.

Poker Walk Rules

- ❖ Individual registration: The first 100 pre-registrants receive a special grab bag and an extra playing card. No prior skill or knowledge of poker is needed to participate. This is not a race so there is no need to hurry.
- ❖ The Poker Walk will consist of two routes to choose from, with an opportunity to collect playing cards at the different poker stations along each route. Walk the one-mile route and receive five cards or walk the two-mile route and receive seven cards. Your winning hand will be the best poker hand out of five cards. Want better odds? Walk the two miles and receive the extra two cards.
- ❖ Each participant will begin at the registration table, located in the Sheriff's Office Training Room. Here they will check-in and receive a map of the designated routes, and if preregistered, collect their first playing card.
- ❖ Each participant can visit a station once to create their best of 5-cards poker hand. If a duplicate card (same suit, same number) is drawn inform the volunteer so you are provided with the opportunity to receive a new card. To keep things fair, each participant's initials will be added to each card prior to leaving the stations.
- ❖ Participants will finish their walk returning to the Sheriff's Office Training Room to collect their final card, turn in their best five cards, and receive a complimentary bottle of water and a snack!
- ❖ The winning poker hands will be ranked as noted below and not on the speed for which they finished the walk. Prizes will be given for the best poker hand and worst poker hand. In the event of a tie, a tiebreaker will be administered by the committee.
- ❖ Keep an eye out for those Jokers! They are instant winners for a \$10 Coffee Gift Card and will be placed in the decks for you to use as wild cards. You can redeem your Joker card prize after the walk in the Sheriff's Training Room.
- ❖ All prizes will be announced by email the following day.

Poker Hand Rankings (Highest to Lowest)

Royal Flush: Run of sequential cards from 10 – A, with all cards of the same suit.

Straight Flush: Run of sequential cards, all cards in the same suit, but not Ace high.

Four of a Kind: Four cards of the same rank e.g., four Aces, four Kings etc.

Full House: Three cards of the same rank plus a pair, e.g., three Aces & pair of Kings.

Flush: Five cards all the same suit.

Straight (Run): Five sequential cards, not of the same suit.

Three of a Kind: Three cards of the same rank e.g., three Aces, three Kings etc.

Two Pair: Two sets of pairs e.g., a pair of Aces and a pair of Kings.

Pair: Two cards of the same rank e.g., two Aces, two Kings etc.

High Card: None of the above, your highest value card in your hand plays.
