Re: Juvenile Court Location Changes

The Lewis County Juvenile Court has relocated to 19 SW Cascade Avenue in Chehalis effective August 5, 2021, in preparation for a substantial renovation and addition to the main Juvenile Court building. This temporary site is most commonly known as the old Legal Aide Building, which is the brick house located off the southeast corner of the Law & Justice parking lot. Due to available space, Juvenile Court Probation Officers and staff will be rotating through this space and others around the county. However, all are available by phone and maybe contacted for assistance during their normal hours. We are staffed and open to the public from 8a-12p and 1p-5p Monday through Friday. However, due to security and space concerns the door is locked and we ask that visitors please knock to notify us of their arrival. Of important note, our mailing address remains the same.

The Juvenile Detention Center will continue to operate in our usual location until October 6, 2021, at which time we will be relocating that department to Maple Lane School on Old HWY 9 in Grand Mound. More information will be coming out about the detention facility as the time approaches.

Although the logistics of these moves and the upcoming project are a challenge, as always, we are committed to our many partners throughout the community and to diligently serving the youth and families of Lewis County with professionalism, dignity, and respect during these unusual circumstances.
