LEWIS COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE TO OPEN RECEPTION AREAS FOR LIMITED HOURS AND SERVICES

The Lewis County Sheriff's Office reception areas will be reopening with limited hours and services on June 22, 2020, with Lewis County moving to Phase 3 Status. The Sheriff's Office will have a customer service window open to serve the public from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. There is a limited waiting area inside the Law and Justice Center lobby, and a cloth face mask/nose-mouth covering is required to be worn while inside the building. We continue asking the public to use other means of conducting business with our office as found on our website, to include: public records requests by phone and e-mail, renewing of Concealed Pistol Licenses by mail, and reporting of crimes via phone to have a deputy contact you. If you need service in person, be aware of potential time delays due to social distancing protocols and available resources. Fingerprinting services, to include original CPL applications, will continue to be conducted via appointment only for Lewis County residents (as previously outlined in our May 28 press release) by scheduling with our office by phone at (360) 748-9286.

In addition, the Lewis County Sheriff's Office Jail reception area will also reopen for limited access from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, starting June 22, 2020. All visitors entering the jail lobby will have their temperature checked and must be wearing a protective cloth face mask/nose-mouth covering while in the building. Visitors with a temperature of 100.4 or above will be required to leave the building immediately. All onsite jail visits must be scheduled online at www.homewav.com 24-hours prior to the intended visit. Onsite visitation hours will be limited to Monday – Friday, 9:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m., and 1:00 p.m. to 3:00 p.m. only. We encourage all friends and family to continue utilizing the offsite/remote visitation process for more accessibility.

For anyone visiting our offices, we encourage them to be mindful of other patrons also visiting and to practice social distancing while conducting business onsite.
