Mixed Paper



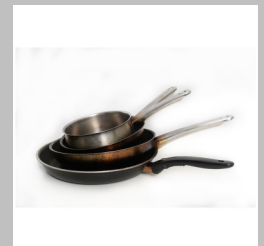
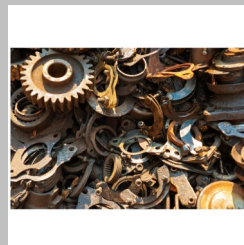
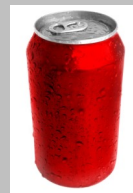
Corrugated Cardboard
