Cowlitz Timber Trails Associations (CTTA) is a private membership recreational vehicle (RV) campground that began in the 1960s. CTTA has approximately 258 campsite lots within or partially within the 200-foot shoreline jurisdiction of the Cowlitz River. This proposal is for the continued buildout of these existing individual camping lots for construction activities on the individual camping lots of 30% coverage or 1,652 square feet whichever is less and the placement of gravel on individual camping lots of up to 20% or 800 square feet whichever is less. The project as proposed requires approvals of Shoreline Substantial Development, Shoreline Conditional Use, Shoreline Variance and Flood Development permits. No expansion or increase in the number of individual camping lots is proposed.
