

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the PUBLIC HEARING scheduled before the LEWIS COUNTY HEARING EXAMINER on July 30, 2020, beginning at 9:00 am, for the purpose of reviewing and deciding an appeal of the State Environmental Policy Act (SEPA) Threshold Determination for file number SEP19-0020 and a Shoreline Substantial Development Permit and Shoreline Conditional Use Permit for file number SHD19-0005 is **canceled** and the SEPA Appeal has been withdrawn.

The Shoreline Public Hearing is re-scheduled to September 29, 2020, beginning at 10:30 am, or shortly thereafter at the Lewis County Courthouse, Commissioners Hearing Room, Second Floor, 351 N.W. North Street, Chehalis, Washington for the purpose of taking public testimony concerning the following project:

Lewis County Public Works proposes to develop a 5.06 acre area into a day-use only public access point to the Cowlitz River in Packwood, as a local recreational facility. The proposed construction will include a gravel parking area with approximately 21 single-vehicle stalls for passenger vehicles and 17 stalls for vehicles with trailers, a double stall ADA-accessible precast concrete vault toilet building, a non-motorized kayak/canoe/boat access point, a 35-foot log stringer pedestrian bridge, and a loop gravel pathway providing access to the Cowlitz River. Additionally, interpretive signs will be mounted on displays around the project area.

The development of the project will include approximately 1,881 cubic yards of fill material and 2,551 cubic yards of cut/grading. The project is located at 105 Alta Drive at Mile Post (MP) 0.045 to 0.055, Packwood, WA on tax parcel numbers 035132005005 & 035147001001 in Lewis County, WA - Sections 15 & 16, Township 13N, Range 09E, WM. Shoreline application file number SHD19-0005.

All interested persons are invited to present testimony relevant to the **SHORELINE SUBSTANTIAL DEVELOPMENT PERMIT AND SHORELINE CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT APPLICATION**. Statements must be received by 4:00 p.m. on the business day preceding the hearing. Verbal and written testimony will be accepted at the public hearing. Phone calls to staff are not considered part of the hearing record. Due to the on-going COVID-19 pandemic and the Governor's most recent limitation on public gatherings, the public hearing may be conducted remotely through Zoom or other virtual meeting platform.
