

## **SHD19-0009 Cowlitz Timber Trails Association (CTTA) Project Virtual Public Hearing Additional Information**

The Lewis County Hearing Examiner will hold a virtual land use hearing on Friday, March 12, 2021, starting at 9:00 a.m., or shortly thereafter for the purpose of taking public testimony and rendering a decision concerning a shoreline substantial development permit, shoreline conditional use permit and shoreline variance permit. This hearing will be by remote virtual hearing only and no in-person public access to the hearing room.
