PROJECT: Repairing a portion of roadway of Pigeon Springs Rd at milepost 2.295 and a portion of bank immediately adjacent to roadway which was destabilized during the flood event in January 2021. Work will include excavation of the eroded bank and roadway, installation of a gravity block wall with underdrains, replacement of corrugated metal pipe with concrete pipe, realigning a segment of roadway and, planting a mix of trees and shrubs.

PROJECT LOCATION: The project is located at milepost 2.295 of Pigeon Springs Rd, Onalaska, Lewis County, WA – Section 06, Township 13 N, Range 02 E, WM on parcel number 033017002004 within the shoreline jurisdiction of the Newaukum River. Lewis County's 2021 Shoreline Master Program designates this area of the Newaukum River as Shoreline Rural Conservancy.

PROCESS: A Notice of Application will be published in the County's Newspaper of Record and will initiate a 30-day public comment period in which interested persons may submit written comments. Once the comment period has ended, the decision will be issued. The decision is appealable to the State Shoreline Hearings Board under Lewis County Shoreline Master Program Section 7.05.05A. Only the applicant and persons submitting written comments within the comment period may appeal the decision to the State Shoreline Hearings Board.

SEPA: Lewis County is Lead Agency for this proposal; A Determination of Non-Significance (DNS) was issued on January 12, 2023, and comments will be received until February 13, 2023.
