How do I borrow a tool?

- Go online, become a member, then check out the tools you need.
- Pick up and return tools at **104 E. Floral St. in Centralia*** on Saturdays from 9 am to 12 pm. (*Corner of S. Tower & E. Floral)

How do I become a member?

1. Complete a Membership Application.
2. Sign and Date the Liability Waiver and Tool Use Policy.
3. Provide identification to verify you are 18 years old and a local resident.

How much will it cost?

The Tool Bucket Library is FREE to join, however, it does cost money to operate even though it is ran by volunteers.

Suggested Annual Donations:

- Seniors / Veterans / Students: \$25
- Regular Membership: \$45
- Community Sponsorship: \$150

Not sure you want to join for a year?

- \$7 for a month
- \$25 for 6 months

Low income? Pay what you can. **NO ONE** will be turned away because of their ability to pay.

We want to encourage pride in home ownership or even acquiring new tool skills to enhance your ability to find better employment.

What if I return a tool late?

All tools must be returned clean and in good working condition within **one week** to avoid a late fee of **\$1 per day per tool**.

Reservations may be extended for an additional week upon request unless tools are already reserved by others.

What are donations and late fees used for?

Our aim is to keep the WSU Master Recycler Composters of Lewis County (*dba MRC Tool Bucket Library*) a financially sustaining 501(c)3, non-profit organization.

We use membership donations and late fees to run this volunteer project by buying and maintaining our tools for the community to share.

Other expenses include liability insurance, repair supplies, library software, and equipment needed for basic operations.

This material is funded through a Participation Grant from the Washington State Department of Ecology.
