Sex Offender Level III Notification

The Lewis County Sheriff's Office is releasing the following information pursuant to RCW 4.24.50, which authorizes law enforcement agencies to inform the public when the release of information will enhance public safety and protection.

The individual who appears on this notification has been convicted of a sex offense that requires registration with the Sheriff's Office. Further, their previous history places them in a classification level that reflects the potential to re-offend. The individual served the sentence imposed by the court and has properly notified the Sheriff's Office of their current address. The law does not require this offender to do anything other than register. **THEY ARE NOT WANTED BY LAW ENFORCEMENT AT THIS TIME. Synopsis of Information: On 02/23/04, Tooley was found guilty in Josephine County Oregon's Circuit Court for one count of Rape 3rd Degree. This conviction stems from Tooley having sexual contact with a known 13-year old female he was not related to when he was 23-years old. Tooley was convicted for Failure to Register as a Sex Offender in 2013 and in

2014, Tooley was convicted of Attempted Rape 3rd Degree in Lewis County, an incident that occurred in 2011. This conviction stems from Tooley having sexual contact with a female he just met. Because of Tooley's crimes, he has been classified as a high risk to re-offend and this community notification is being made.

Using this public information to threaten, intimidate or harass sex offenders will not be tolerated by the law enforcement agencies of Lewis County. This abuse could potentially terminate our ability to release this important information to the public.
