Youth Substance Abuse Prevention Town Hall Dec. 11

Centralia, WA – A town hall to educate community members about local youth substance abuse and prevention will be held in the Centralia Middle School Commons at 4 p.m. Tuesday, December 11, 2018. The Lewis County Public Health & Social Services (LCPHSS) prevention team will share information about the new Community Prevention and Wellness Initiative (CPWI) coming to Centralia.

Centralia area community members are encouraged to attend to learn, share, and engage with your neighbors to support Centralia area youth in becoming healthy, capable, contributing, and caring individuals. The Centralia Middle School Commons is located at 901 Johnson Road in Centralia.

Centralia is one of a number of communities statewide participating in CPWI through grant funding from the Washington State Health Care Authority. CPWI's primary goals are to reduce underage use of alcohol and drugs, improve academic performance, and reduce juvenile crime. Grant funding supports prevention efforts and will help community members work collaboratively to support youth in making healthy choices.
